

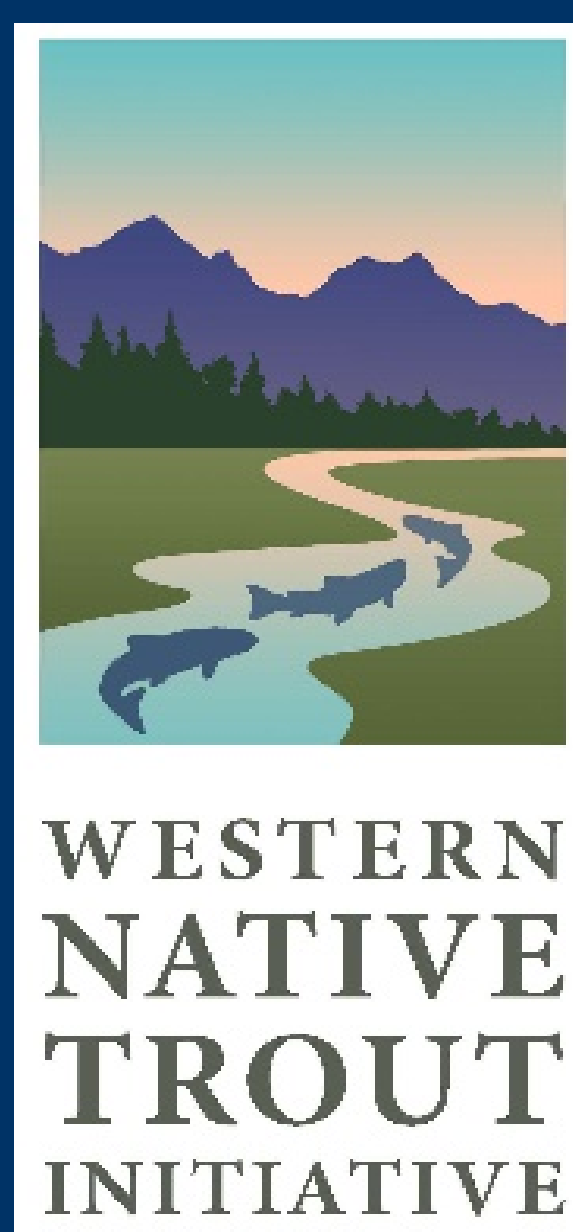

Pacific Marine and Estuarine FHP

- Protects, restores, and enhances juvenile fish habitat and connectivity among habitats in the nearshore Pacific Ocean and California, Oregon and Washington estuaries.
- Supports and promotes the protection, restoration, and enhancement of water quality and quantity to improve the function of estuarine and nearshore marine environments.

Pacific Lamprey FHP protects and restores fish habitat that:

- Improves lamprey populations to support traditional tribal cultural use.
- Restore Pacific lamprey populations and their habitats to improve ecosystem function.
- Fill gaps and augment existing partnerships.

Western Native Trout Initiative

- Along the Northwest coast, WNTI supports coastal cutthroat trout data collection, conservation planning and habitat enhancement projects.
- In Alaska, WNTI supports native trout and char data collection, conservation planning and habitat enhancement projects, including protection and enhancement of water quality and quantity of coastal freshwater systems.

California Fish Passage Forum

- Remediates barriers to effective fish migration.
- Facilitates coordination and communication among entities working on fish passage.
- Identifies, assesses, and prioritizes the removal of fish passage barriers.
- Disseminates guidelines and design criteria for replacement of barriers.

Southwest Alaska Salmon FHP

- Protects, conserves, and, if necessary, restores watersheds that sustain wild salmon populations and the fisheries of Southwest Alaska.

Mat-Su Basin Salmon FHP

- Protects salmon and their habitats in the Mat-Su Basin and Upper Cook Inlet, mitigates threats to salmon and their habitats, restores connectivity between salmon habitats, and increases knowledge about salmon and their use of freshwater and marine habitats.

Kenai Peninsula FHP

- Creates and fosters effective collaboration to maintain healthy fish, people, habitat and economies in the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

Southeast Alaska FHP

- Supports cooperative habitat conservation, restoration, and management in freshwater, estuarine and marine ecosystems across Southeast Alaska with consideration of economic, social, and cultural interests of local communities.
